WHEREAS, Petitioner has a public high school located at 410 Garfield Street, Statesville, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Petitioner submitted an application for a barber school permit for Greyhound Barber Academy on July 11, 2022, with the proposed school to be located at 474 North Center Street, Statesville, North Carolina; and

WHEREAS, Petitioner proposes to have the school at a temporary location while a permanent location is developed; and

WHEREAS, the practical area for the temporary location is 30 square feet short of the 896-square-foot requirement in 21 N.C. Admin. Code 06F .0101(b)(3); and

WHEREAS, the State has an interest in increasing the number of barbers available in the industry in North Carolina and maximizing competition; and

WHEREAS, allowing the barber school to operate online for a limited period of time with the reduced-size practical area will increase school choices for barber students and provide career options to students;

NOW, THEREFORE, in lieu of further proceedings authorized by N.C. Gen. Stat. § 150B, the parties agree to the following:

1. Respondent allows Petitioner to operate a barber school with a practical area that has

- a reduced size, under the following conditions:
- a. Petitioner shall adhere to all Board-related General Statutes and Administrative Rules administered by the Board;
 - b. Petitioner affirms by signing this consent order that the barber school meets all other regulatory requirements, to the best of Petitioner's knowledge;
 - c. Petitioner may operate at the temporary location until August 31, 2024, or until the school opens at the new location, whichever is sooner;
 - d. Petitioner shall submit a new barber school application and receive approval from the board before operating at the new location; and
 - e. Petitioner shall notify the Board of any change in circumstances that may affect this agreement.
2. Any violation of this Consent Order shall constitute just cause for the termination of same.
 3. Respondent may use this document as evidence in any future proceeding in which Petitioner is a party.
 4. This Consent Order constitutes the entire agreement between the parties, and there are no understandings or other agreements between the parties;
 5. This Consent Order is in lieu of further administrative or civil proceedings and fully resolves the pending issues between the parties.
 6. Petitioner has read this Consent Order, has been afforded the opportunity to consult with an attorney, and executes same as his own free and voluntary act, absent any coercion by, or reliance upon the advice of, Respondent.
