Dear schools,

The board is changing the format for student permits, and this email explains the impact on schools.

New look

Unlike the existing blue student permits, the new ones will be printed on the same card stock as all other license types (registered barber, apprentice barber, barber instructor, barber school, and barbershop). I've attached a sample to show you what the student permit will look like. The red lettering will appear on the permit you receive.

Why we're making this change

This change will eliminate a largely manual process for preparing student permits, which in turn will allow us to send them to you quicker.

What about the existing blue student permits?

This change will be effective from today forward, so you'll have a number of students who have the old format. That's fine – you can continue to use those student permits. However, if you prefer all your students to have the same format (maybe you don't want any members of the public to be confused by the different formats), please send a list of student names to barberboard@nc.gov and request replacement student permits. Important: if you request replacements, don't send in the old ones until the student has terminated from your school. That way, we don't accidentally mark the student as dropped if he or she was actually just getting a replacement license.

School responsibility

Please keep track of these student permits so that students don't try to use them in barbershops unlawfully. The red lettering will help alert the public that the permit can't be used outside of the school setting.
